Serve & Connect to host 2023 Illuminight Gala on March 3

(Columbia, SC) Serve & Connect will host its annual fundraiser, the Illuminight Gala, on March 3 at Central Energy in Columbia. Illuminight Gala is the nonprofit's signature fundraising event set to celebrate the organization's mission, including the presentation of the Greg Alia Award and the Changemaker Award. The Illuminight Gala will feature special guest and keynote speaker David O. Brown Superintendent of the Chicago Police Department. Superintendent Brown holds more than 30 years of law enforcement experience to Chicago and is nationally recognized for his expertise in public safety, community policing, and reform.

Since joining CPD, Brown has prioritized community engagement and building trust in Chicago's communities. As part of this effort, the Department launched multiple initiatives focused on making the city's neighborhoods safer through community partnership. Prior to being named Superintendent in Chicago, Brown previously served as the Chief of the Dallas Police Department from 2010-2016. He is also the author of a memoir: Call to Rise.

"Superintendent Brown brings immense leadership and a commitment to rebuilding community trust through partnerships.
